Re: Blasting in Bear Creek Village

Please be advised that very soon blasting will be occurring in Bear Creek Village near Laurelbrook Estates. This is part of the ongoing development of Laurelbrook Estates. The company doing this work is Holbert Explosive. They have advised the Township that they will:

1. Post the area where the blasting is to occur.
2. Post signs at the entranceway to Laurelbrook.
3. Go door-to-door to notify all residents within 500 feet of the blasting zone.
4. Sound an air horn before any blasting as a warning for residents.

In addition to the steps outlined above, Holbert has advised us that they are placing seismographic equipment in the home that is closest to the blasting zone. The company has all of its state permits for this project, and is working with our office to ensure we have all necessary local permits and they will also provide us with proof of insurance.

Once blasting begins, they hope to be completed in 3-4 days. This is dependent upon good weather and no unexpected problems.

We will keep you informed of any changes via our website. Although we do not expect any issues from this work, if you experience any problems or feel your home or property has been damaged. Please contact the township building immediately.
